Sustainability – why choose SAF

The aviation industry has taken enormous strides in reducing the environmental impact of flying, especially in the areas of engine efficiency and reducing aircraft weight (and hence fuel consumption) reduction through the increased use of composite materials in manufacture.

There has also been much progress in the development of sustainable aviation fuel, SAF. SAF is produced from sustainable feedstocks, or even recycled oils and fats, and is very similar in its chemistry to traditional fossil jet fuel. Using SAF results in a reduction in carbon emissions

compared to the traditional jet fuel it replaces over the lifecycle of the fuel.

SAF offers an impressive reduction of 80 per cent or more in carbon emissions over the life cycle of the fuel, compared with the traditional jet fuel it replaces, depending on the sustainable feedstock used, production method and the supply chain to the airport. It is currently more expensive than traditional jet fuel (with which it can also be blended), but your team will be happy to quote for using SAF as part of your charter requirement.
